ARMS ALLOWED: 22 CALIBER PISTOL OR REVOLVER (RULE 3.4) TARGETS: FIFTY FOOT B-2 FOR SLOW FIRE, B-3 FOR TIMED AND RAPID

ELIGIBILITY: Adult competitors must be a member of the NRA and their resident state shooting organization (SD Shooting Sports Assoc. for SD residents). Junior competitors may be a member of the NRA or a member of an affiliated club. Team members must represent the same NRA or SDSSA club. MEMBERSHIP CARDS WILL BE REQUIRED.

REGISTRATION FEES: Registration--\$15.00, and each competitor will be provided a copy of the final bulletin.

Entry Fee--\$10.00 Team (4 member)--\$8.00

- ENTRIES: Advance entries are requested. Mail registration cards and fees to contact to arrive 2 days prior to match date. Indicate relay preference. 'There will be 10 entries per relay.
- CLASSIFICATION: Competitors will be classified according to NRA Classification System in all matches. Be ready to show Classification Cards and Score Books on request. Unclassified Competitors will shoot in Master Class.

FIRING TIMES: March 8 -Relays at 10:30 AM, 12:00 PM, AND 1:30 PM

MATCH SCHEDULE: MATCH 1—20 rounds slow fire MATCH 3—20 rounds timed fire MATCH 5—SD Individual Championship: Aggregate of Matches 1-4. MATCH 6—Team Championship: Scores of Match 2

AWARDS: 70% of entry fees will be returned to competitors. Matches 1—4 =Match Winner and Class Awards. Special Awards: High SD Resident SD Indoor Pistol Champion Plaque (provided by SDSSA) If winner is nonresident, a suitable award will be provided by the sponsor. High Senior Champion and SD junior Champion awards will be provided if 2 or more competitors compete in these categories. (Provided by sponsor) Class Awards, match 1-5, 1st—3 or more entries, 2nd—7 or more entries, 3rd—11 or more entries in a class. If less than 3 entries, they will compete for match awards only or be combined with the next higher class. Competitors of a lower class will not be combined with the Master Class.
