Eligibility: A competitor may enter only one NRA Sectional of each type during 2007.

All adult U.S. shooters must be members of the NRA.

Rules: Current NRA rules will govern. .22 cal. Conventional Pistol 3.4, Standard Pistol 3.5, Air Pistol 3.7, Free Pistol 3.6

Targets: Conventional B-2 and B-3 (50 feet), Standard Pistol B-33 (50 feet), Air Pistol B-40 (33 feet), Free Pistol B-11 (50 feet).

Classification: Current NRA classification will be used. All unclassified shooters will fire in the Master Class.
