LOCATION: MAILING ADDRESS IS CENTRAL CITY, IA. MATSELL BRIDGE NATURAL AREA IS LOCATED 3.1 MILES NORTH OF VIOLA, IA. DIRECTIONS: PROCEED 3.1 MILES STRAIGHT NORTH FROM VIOLA ON STONE CITY ROAD. THE ROAD WILL TWIST AND TURNS SOME. STONE CITY ROAD BECOMES MATSELL ROAD. CROSS THE WAPSIPINICON RIVER TURN RIGHT IMMEDIATELY. THIS IS A LINN COUNTY PARK FACILITY. OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. THE RANGE IS 300 YARDS FROM THE PARK RANGERS RESIDENCE.

ELIGIBILITY: CLOSED : IOWA RESIDENTS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE IOWA STATE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION. APPLICATIONS FOR THE IOWA STATE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION WILL BE AVAILABLE. FIRST YEAR ISR&PA MEMBERSHIP IS FREE. NON-RESIDENTS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THEIR HOME STATE ASSOCIATION. BE PREPARED TO SHOW MEMBERSHIP CARDS. NRA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED ONLY IF SHOOTING TO SET NATIONAL SCORING RECORDS.

FACILITIES: 30 FIRING POSITIONS WITH TURNING TARGETS AT 25 YDS. COVERED FIRING LINE.

ENTRIES: LIMITED TO 30 IN 1 RELAY EACH DAY. POST ENTRIES ACCEPTED TO RANGE CAPACITY, PREFERENCE GIVEN TO ACROSS THE BOARD REGISTRANTS. LAST ENTRY 8:55AM MATCH DAY.

RULES: NRA RULES WILL GOVERN MATCH. \$1.00 CHALLENGE FEE. REFIRES AND ALIBIS ARE ALLOWED. COMPETITORS WILL SCORE AND REPAIR TARGETS. BRING A STAPLE GUN

CLASSIFICATION: NRA CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM WILL BE USED. UNCLASSIFIED COMPETITORS WILL FIRE IN THE MASTER CLASS. ANY CLASS WITH LESS THAN 5 WILL BE COMBINED WITH THE NEXT HIGHER CLASS STARTING WITH MARKSMAN CLASS. LESS THAN 5 MASTERS WILL SHOOT FOR WIN ONLY.

MATCH ENTRY FEES: THE ENTRY FEE FOR EACH MATCH IS \$2.50. ACROSS THE BOARD ENTRY FEE FOR ALL MATCHES IS \$40.00.

CMP SERVICE PISTOL “Leg” MATCH

ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 to be paid at the range upon filling out the special Entry/Score Card.

OPEN TO: Any citizen of the United States 16 years of age or older. Distinguished personnel are eligible to compete, however if range facilities limit the number of entries which can be accepted, priority will be given to non-Distinguished competitors.

ENTRIES: Indicate on NRA Registration Entry card by circling Match 20. Actual entry will be accomplished at the range with a special card to be completed.

DATE: To be fired following the completion of the .45 Caliber Team Match #18.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 10:00AM Saturday Sept. 25, 2010 or 10:00AM Sunday Sept 26, 2010.

RULES: Governed by the rules prescribed by the Corporation for the Promotion of Rifle Practice and Firearms Safety, Inc.

COURSE OF FIRE: Pistol National Match Course

First Stage - Slow Fire, 50 yards – B8, Standard American 50 yard target, 1 series of 10 shots in 10 minutes, scoring after 10 shots.

Second Stage - Timed Fire, 25 yards – B6, Standard American 25 yard target with only 9 and 10 rings blacked, known as the “25-yard rapid fire pistol target”, 2 strings (5 shots each); 20 seconds per string, scoring after 10 shots.

Third Stage - Rapid Fire, 25 yards – B6, Standard American 25 yard target with only 9 and 10 rings blacked, known as the “25- yard rapid fire pistol target”, 2 strings (5 shots each); 10 seconds per string, scoring after 10 shots.

FIREARM: Pistol, US Caliber .45 M1911, M1911A1; 9mm, M9 having not less than 4 pound trigger pull as prescribe for use in the National Matches.

AMMUNITION: The competitor will provide ammunition approved by CMP rules.

AWARDS: Credit toward Distinguished designation. Excellence-in-Competition Badges will be provided by CMP for those who qualify for this award.
