#4, #9, #14--20 Shot Rapid Fire @ 25 yards on a B-8 target.

#5, #10, #15--Subaggregates of 22cal, Center Fire & 45cal Matches.

#16--2700 Grand Aggregate

Rules: Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will apply.

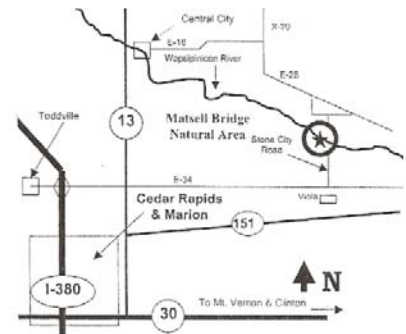
Challenge Fee: \$1.00

I am told that lunch will be available at the range, otherwise lunch is available within 10 miles.

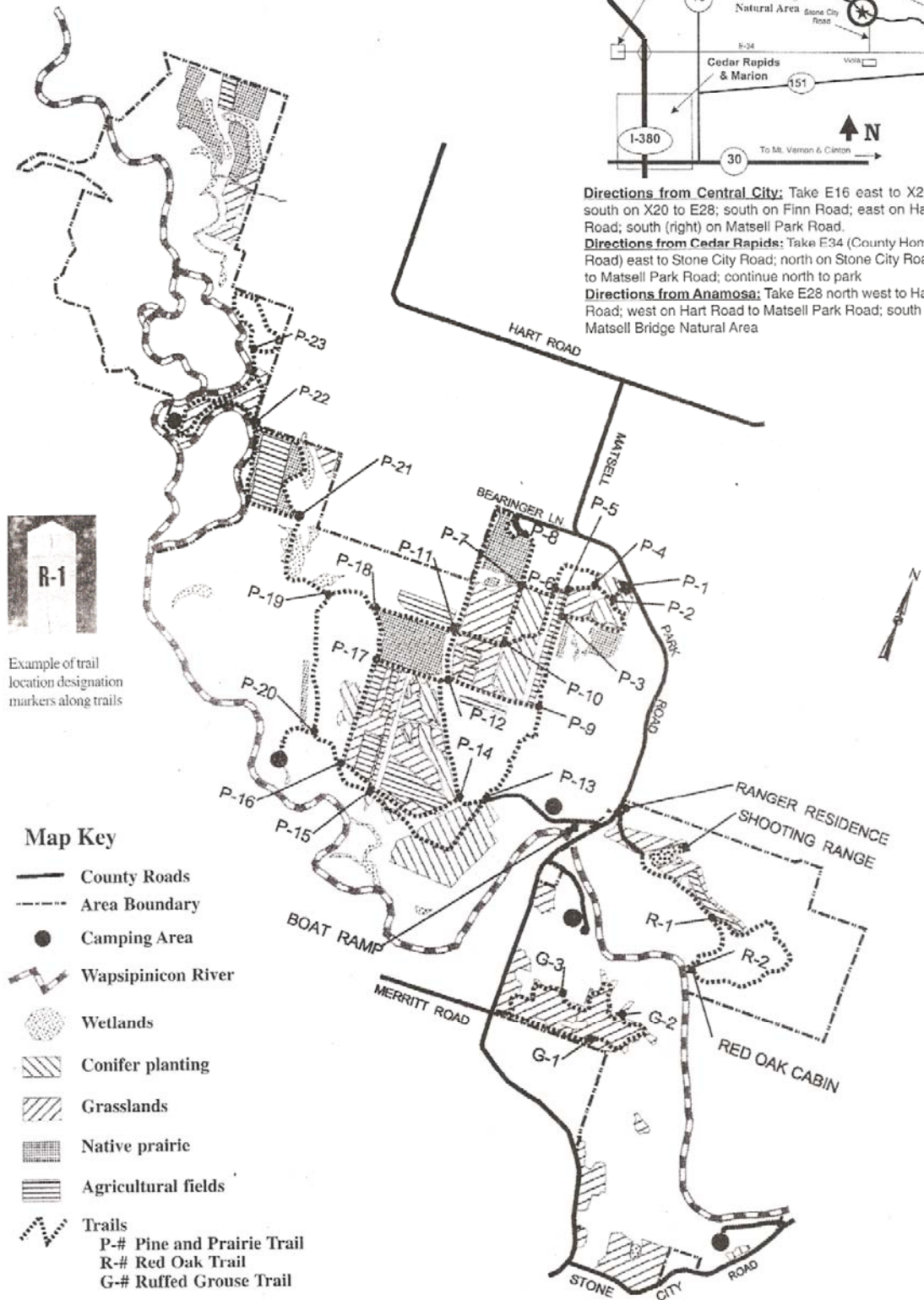
# Matsell Bridge Natural Area



**Directions from Central City:** Take E16 east to X20; south on X20 to E28; south on Finn Road; east on Hart Road; south (right) on Matsell Park Road.

**Directions from Cedar Rapids:** Take E34 (County Home Road) east to Stone City Road; north on Stone City Road to Matsell Park Road; continue north to park.

**Directions from Anamosa:** Take E28 north west to Hart Road; west on Hart Road to Matsell Park Road; south to Matsell Bridge Natural Area.

## Trail Locations

The letter and number combinations on the map indicate a location on a particular trail. For example, P-1 is a numbered post on the Pine & Prairie Trail.
