(Rules 2.10, 2.11, 2.12, 2.13, 2.14). No pickup teams  
allowed. Tournament officials may not compete.

RANGE: 18 firing points. Slow fire will be at 50 yds on  
B-6 targets. Time and Rapid fire will be at 25 yds with  
turning targets on B-8 targets.

CLASSES: Classes will not be combined. There must be a minimum  
of eight (8) competitors in a class for 2nd place,  
thirteen (13) for 3rd place. No awards will be  
provided below 3rd place.
