RULES: Current N.R.A. rules apply. Challenge fee: \$1.00. Challenges will be decided by a jury made up of range officers and caller. Competitors will change targets and score. Each competitor is expected to bring a staple gun, staples and target repair tape. Use of a plug type-scoring device restricted to the RANGE OFFICIALS.
EYE AND EAR PROTECTION IS MANDATORY.

ENTRY INFO: Competition is open but limited to one relay of 30 shooters. Relay starts promptly at 8:57 a.m. The N.R.A classification system will be used. Entries close at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday evening prior to the match.

AWARDS: A poll was taken of active Bullseye shooters and the consensus was that awards didn't matter – match conditions were more important. Also, entry fees were getting rather high for those who came to matches regularly. So, rather than giving awards, we reduced the entry fees. A match bulletin will be sent after each match listing scores and acknowledging aggregate class and match winners. As this is an approved match, results will be sent to the N.R.A. and will count towards classifications.

MISCELLANEOUS: Cold pop will be sold all day. Outhouse facilities and cold water will be available. The range has 30 covered firing points with stationary targets at 50 yards and turning targets at 25 yards. The range will not be available for sighting-in or practices. Fast food and full service restaurants are 10-minutes away. Usually, one hour is allowed for lunch.
