ELIGIBILITY: Competitors can only enter one Pistol Sectional during 2009.

TEAMS: A team will consist of 4 firing members representing an NRA affiliated club, law enforcement agency, service, National Guard or reserve unit. Teams composed of competitors not all in the same category are mixed teams and not eligible for National awards or rankings.

The team match will be fired immediately after the individual Rapid Fire Match. All teams must be organized and registered before the first member fires. **YOU HAVE TO ARRANGE FOR YOUR OWN TEAM**

RULES: Current NRA Pistol Rules will govern.
Challenges: \$1.00

EQUIPMENT: .22 Cal. Pistol (Rule 3.4)
DISTANCE: 50 feet (Turning Targets)

SOUVENIR AWARDS: Each Competitor will receive a souvenir Sectional Pin.

CLASSIFICATION: All competitors will be classified according to the NRA Classification System in individual and team matches and must be prepared to show their Classification Card or Temporary Score Book. Unclassified shooters will fire in the Master Class.
