

**NORTH STAR RIFLE CLUB C0514**  
**MINNESOTA MRP CHAMPIONSHIP F OPEN/F TR/SLING**  
**AN NRA REGISTERED TOURNAMENT**  
**NRA REGISTRATION 2021169487**

- LOCATION:** North of Red Wing, Mn. off Hwy 61 to MM 98-99 on Greenspring Road. Turn up hill at Greenspring and follow road to range (about 1 mile). **PLEASE** observe 20 MPH speed limit on Greenspring and **10 MPH** signs at top of the hill.
- DATE/TIME:** May 29-30, 2021 Entries close 0815 brief at 0835 & pit seals at 0845 Sat. and Sun.
- RAIN/SNOW DAY:** If Saturday rained/snowed out there will be a 1 day individual championship on Sun. May 30. The alternate course of fire will still be the 3X600.
- RULES:** Current NRA Mid Range Prone.
- ALCOHOL:** Consumption of alcohol is prohibited until completion of the match, all shots have been fired and all equipment off the line. Alcohol consumption is allowed only in the parking lot behind 600 and in the camp ground. **NOTE:** This does not prohibit practice after the match for those not consuming.
- COMPETITION OPEN TO:** All shooters. NRA membership not required. NSRC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry but we can't imagine why we would. Reject that is!

- CAMPING:** North Star campground will be open about noon Friday. Contact Bob for gate code if you want to arrive sooner.
- ELECTRIC TARGETS:** We plan to have 20 Shotmarker electronic targets ready for use at this match.
- REFUNDS:** Partial refunds of entry fee made in the event of a partial rain out. Full refunds for a full rain out. Amount TBD depending on how many matches completed.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$50.00 both days, \$6.00 to MRRA & \$5.50 to NRA.
- FOULING SHOTS:** Match 1 both days will feature unlimited sighters and 2 convertible thereafter.
- TARGETS:** MR full face with MR-F centers and your tablet will be set for appropriate target.
- INDIVIDUAL MATCHES SAT.**
- Match 1: Unlimited sighting shots and 20 for record any sight 22 minutes any sight  
Match 2: Two convertible sighters and 20 shots for record 22 minutes any sight  
Match 3: Two Convertible sighting shots and 20 for record iron sights  
Match 4: Same as match 3  
Match 5: An aggregate of 1 thru 4
- INDIVIDUAL MATCHES SUN.**
- MATCH 6: Unlimited sighting shots and 20 for record iron sights  
MATCH 7: Two convertible sighters and 20 for record iron sights  
MATCH:8 Same as match 7  
MATCH 9: An aggregate of 6,7 & 8  
MATCH 10: An aggregate of match 5 & 9.
- NOTE 1:** MRRA rules now allow non residents to be a state champion IF they are a member of MRRA. PLEASE log on to mrra.org for an application BEFORE the match.
- AWARDS:** North Star is going to a fixed award schedule for this tournament and that schedule will be not less than at previous similar tournaments based on 20-25 shooters.
- CATEGORY AWARDS:** There will be a \$6.00 category award for those shooting Palma rifle or Service rifle in all matches if 4 or more entries. There will be a \$6.00 category award for junior, senior, grand senior & woman with at least 4 entries. There will be an optics only category award with at least 4 entries but optics all the way can not be state champ or MW
- DUTIES:** Competitors will be required to score other shooters on their assigned target.
- SQUADDING:** See page 3 for squadding details.



## **2021 MRP SQUADDING F CLASS AND SLING COMBINED**

The MRRA has determined that the F class and sling MRP championships should be combined in 2021 to create an open date for some other tournament. They then assigned the combined tournament to North Star on May 29-30, Memorial Day weekend. North Star then agreed to buy 10 more Shot Marker targets for a total of 20. As of early Jan. 2021 we know not what issues will inhibit attendance but in order to accommodate as many as possible we will use the below guidelines.

Initially entries will be limited to 80 on 4 relays with 40 spots for sling and 40 for F class. Since we last talked someone suggested to the extent possible all F class on relay 1 and all sling on relay 2. If there are 40 F class the 3<sup>rd</sup> relay will be all F class and R 4 will be the remainder of sling shooters. However be advised the numbers may not work out this smoothly so be prepared to have sling and F class mixed. Those spots will be reserved on a first come first served basis for those submitting an entry with payment postmarked **no sooner** than April 1, 2021. Once 40 F class and 40 sling entries have been received you will be placed on a standby list until May 1. If either does not fill with 40 shooters by May 1 those on the standby list will be contacted in the order they were placed on the standby list and offered a spot. Based on past attendance we believe it's likely sling will not fill with 40 shooters but we will save 40 spots until May 1 for either type gun. If we fill with 80 shooters we will open relay 5 to accommodate the extras up to 20 additional.

In order to simplify targets everybody will shoot on the MR-F center placer over the MR full face and your screen will be selected for the proper target.

Here are the highlights.

1. Any entry postmarked before April 1, 2022 will be rejected. Phone in entries **WILL NOT** be accepted.
2. Entries **WITH** payment postmarked after April 1, 2021 will be accepted up to 40 F class and 40 sling.
3. Once 40 of whichever gun are accepted your entry will be placed on a wait list until May 1.
4. If there are openings for your gun you will be notified by email of an opening at which time you must confirm or not.
5. If we fill with 80 shooters in any combination we will accept up to 20 more on relay 5.
6. We will NOT resquad the first 4 relays to distribute shooters evenly. In other words if we have 82 shooters the last 2 entries will shoot on relay 5.
7. Course of fire will be 4X600 Sat and 3X600 Sunday.
